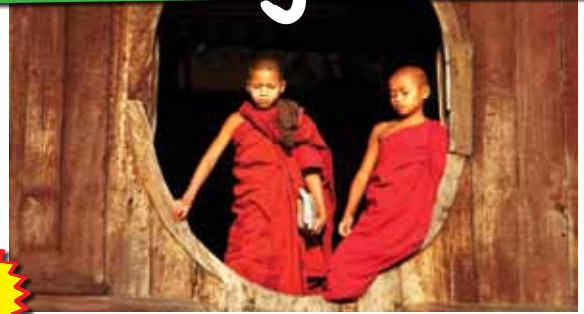

### Day 11: Mandalay – Monywa – Powintaung – Monywa.

Transfer to Monywa on the banks of the Chindwin River. En route visit Thanboddhay Pagoda and Boditahtaung Pagoda. Proceed to Po Win Taung by open-air jeeps. The complex consists of 947 sandstone caves and contains the richest collection of mural paintings and Buddhist statues in South East Asia. (B)  
*Accommodation: Win Unity Resort Hotel (Superior room), Monywa – 1 night*

**Day 12: Monywa – Pakkoku – Bagan.** Transfer to Pakokku via Ah Nyeint, Ah Myint and Ma U Ah Le villages. Short rickshaw ride through town before lunch at local restaurant at the port. Board private boat for 2 hour cruise to Bagan. Transfer to hotel. (B)  
*Accommodation: Amazing Bagan Hotel or similar, Bagan – 3 nights*

**Day 13: Bagan.** Day tour of Bagan including Thagyar Pone Temple, Ananda Temple, Myinkaba Village, Gubyaukgyi Temple and local Bagan workshops. Lunch at Shwe Myanmar, a local favourite. Late this afternoon relaxing horse cart ride through temple area. (B)

**Day 14: Bagan.** Choice of excursions today: Swe Daw Lay Su Legendary Tour or excursion to Mount Popa & Salay or Biking & Community Tour. (B,L)

**Day 15: Bagan – Yangon.** Transfer to airport for flight to Yangon. Arrival transfer to hotel. Yangon city tour, including: historic post office, Sule Paya, Mahabandoola Garden, Independent monument, Little India, Chinatown finishing up at Bogyoke Market where you can browse the stalls for handicrafts and other goods. (B)  
*Accommodation: Summit Park View Hotel, Yangon – 1 night*

**Day 16: Yangon – Australia.** Day at leisure before transfer to airport. Fly from Yangon to Australia arriving day 17. (B)

Learn of the fascinating and compelling history surrounding both Myanmar and Cambodia by visiting sites of great historical significance. Cambodia and Myanmar are home to some of the world's great wonders such as Angkor Wat and the impressive U Bein Bridge. Visit revered temples and discover the skilled craftsmanship of local people as you tour Cambodia and Myanmar in depth.

### Itinerary

**Day 1: Australia - Phnom Penh.** Fly from Australia to Phnom Penh, Cambodia – via Bangkok. Transfer from airport to hotel. Orientation Cyclo tour of Phnom Penh to see sights such as Wat Phnom, the Royal Palace, Silver Pagoda and National museum. Evening sunset river cruise.

*Accommodation: Juliana Hotel (Superior room), Phnom Penh – 2 nights*

**Day 2: Phnom Penh.** Morning tour to the Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum and the Killing fields of Choeung Ek. Visit the humanitarian organisation Pour un Sourire d'Enfant Centre (for the smile of a child). (B,L)

**Day 3: Phnom Penh – Siem Reap.** Transfer to Siem Reap visiting the Skun spider sanctuary en route. Transfer to hotel. Visit famous Angkor Temples by local tuk tuk. Visit to the magnificent Angkor Wat. (B)

*Accommodation: Steung Siem Reap Hotel (Superior room), Siem Reap – 2 nights*

**Day 4: Siem Reap.** Visit the completely overgrown temple, Beng Mealwa. Boat trip on the Tonle Sap Lake, South East Asia's largest freshwater lake. Visit Kampong Kleang – a local lake village on stilts. (B)

**Day 5: Siem Reap - Yangon.** Transfer from hotel to airport. Fly from Siem Reap to Yangon, Myanmar. Transfer from airport to hotel. Afternoon guided tour including Kandawgyi Park and Shwedagon Pagoda, the most revered Buddhist temple in Myanmar. Enjoy breathtaking views of the city skyline and the 8-sided central stupa which is gilded with gold leaf and surrounded by 64 smaller stupas. (B)

*Accommodation: Summit Park View Hotel (Superior), Yangon – 1 night*

**Day 6: Yangon – Heho – Inle Lake.** Transfer to airport. Fly from Yangon to Heho. Scenic one-hour drive to Inle Lake, stopping at the wooden Shwe Yan Pyay Monastery. Board a private motorboat for cruise on Inle Lake, visiting Nga Hpe Chaung Monastery, famous for its 'jumping cats', Phaung Daw Oo Pagoda, weaving village of Inpawkhone and Burmese cigar factory. (B)

*Accommodation: Paradise Inlet Lodge (superior room), Inle Lake – 2 nights*

**Day 7: Inle Lake – In Dein – Inle Lake.** Visit lakes morning market which is used by Lake Inhabitants and local hill tribes. Optional (not included) cooking course with local family. Continue down a small canal to village of In Dein and explore the village by foot or visit a local school. (B)

**Day 8: Inle Lake – Heho – Mandalay.** Transfer to airport. Fly from Heho to Mandalay. Transfer from airport to hotel. Afternoon at leisure, transfer to Mandalay Hill to watch the sun set over the town. (B)

*Accommodation: Mandalay City Hotel (Superior room), Mandalay – 3 nights*

**Day 9: Mandalay – Sagaing – Ava – Amarapura – Mandalay.** Day excursion around Mandalay, exploring the former capitals of Ava, Sagaing and Amarapura. Sagaing Hill is widely regarded as the religious centre of Myanmar, home to 3,000 monks and 100 meditation centres. Visit Sagaing's local market, a typical Burmese market that few tourists visit. Continue to Ava and see the old wooden Bagaya Monastery and the remains of the Royal Palace and Fort, by horse and carriage. Travel to Amarapura and visit a silk weaving workshop and U Bein Bridge. (B,L)

**Day 10: Mandalay – Mingun – Mandalay.** Transfer to Mandalay jetty and board private local boat for one hour cruise on the Irrawaddy River to Mingun. Visit the sites of Mingun: Mingun Pahtodawgyi, the beautiful white Hsinbyume Pagoda and the Mingun Bell. Return to Mandalay and see Mahamuni Pagoda, Kuthodaw Pagoda and Shwenandaw Monastery. (B)
