Itinerary

Day 1: Fly Australia to Cape Town via Johannesburg.

Transfer to Hotel.

Accommodation: Breakwater Lodge (or similar), Cape Town - 2 nights.

Day 2: Cape Town.

Travel along the Atlantic seaboard via Hout Bay and Chapman's Peak, visit the Cape Point Nature Reserve, returning along the Indian Ocean coastline. Enjoy an afternoon cable car ascent up Table Mountain. (B)

Day 3: Cape Town to Calvinia (Hantam Region).

Pass through the picturesque Namaqualand, visit the historic town of Calvinia. (B)

Accommodation: Hantam Huis (or similar), Calvinia.

Day 4: Au-grabies Falls National Park.

Depart from Karoo and head north to the Au-grabies Falls National Park. Spend the afternoon viewing the falls from its many viewpoints. (B)

Accommodation: Vergelegen Guest House (or similar), Au-grabies Falls.

Day 5-6: Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park.

Head north into the Kalahari and the magnificent Kgalagadi Transfrontier National Park, one of the largest reserves found in Africa. Morning and afternoon game viewing. (B)

Accommodation: Xaus Lodge (or similar), Kgalagadi - 2 nights.

Day 7-8: Fish River Canyon.

Head west and enter Namibia. Fish River Canyon is one of the largest and most awe inspiring canyons in the world. (B)

Accommodation: Vogelstrausskluft Country Lodge (or similar), Fish River Canyon - 2 nights.

Day 9-10: Sesriem.

Continue north through ever changing scenery to the Namib Desert. Enjoy a sunset walk in the dunes. Visit Sossusvlei and Sesriem Canyon. (B)

Accommodation: Desert Camp (or similar) Sesriem - 2 nights.

Day 11-12: Swakopmund.

Reach the coast at Walvis Bay and then continue onto Swakopmund. Explore this famous German colonial town or book one of the numerous optional excursions (own expense) (B)

Accommodation: Swakopmund Boutique Hotel (or similar), Swakopmund

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Day 13: Damaraland – Twyfelfontein.

View Bushmen painting/rock engravings as well as the Organ Pipes.

Accommodation: *Ugab Terrace Lodge (or similar), Twyfelfontein.*

Day 14: Himba Visit – Etosha National Park.

Visit a Himba tribe, a semi-nomadic tribe, living in scattered settlements throughout this region. Continue onto Etosha National Park.

Accommodation: *Okaukuejo Restcamp (or similar) - Etosha National Park.*

Day 15: Etosha National Park.

Enjoy early morning and late afternoon game drives with an opportunity to see thousands of wild animals such as: blue wildebeest, springbok, zebra, kudu, giraffe, cheetah, leopard, lion and elephant.

Accommodation: *Restcamp Accommodation, Etosha National Park*

Day 16-17: Okavango River

Enter the Caprivi Strip and spend 2 nights set amongst the lush vegetation overlooking the Okavango River. Enjoy sunset on the deck or a swim in the famous "river pool". The following day is free for optional excursions (own account) such as bird walks, game drives, mokoro excursions.

Accommodation: *Ngepi Camp, Okavango River - 2 nights*

Day 18-19: Chobe National Park.

Chobe is famous for its beautiful scenery, magnificent sunsets and abundance of wildlife and birdlife.

Accommodation: *Chobe Safari Lodge (or similar), Chobe – 2 nights.*

Day 20-21: Livingstone – Victoria Falls.

Travel across the Zambia border to Victoria Falls – without a doubt one of the greatest and most spectacular sights in Africa. Days are spent at leisure to browse the local markets, to experience the many optional activities available.

Accommodation: *Protea Hotel (or similar), Livingstone – 2 nights.*

Day 22: Safari Ends.

Transfer to Livingstone Airport. Fly to Australia via Johannesburg.

Day 23: Arrive Australia

Optional Activities (own expense):

- **Swakopmund:** Sand boarding, quad biking, skydiving, kayaking, hot air ballooning or scenic flights over the vast Namib Desert.
- **Okavango River:** Bird walks, game drives and mokoro excursions.
- **Chobe:** Game drives.
- **Victoria Falls:** White water rafting, bungi jumping, micro lighting/airplane or helicopter flights over the Falls, rhino walks, elephant bank safaris and a visit to the falls.
