Itinerary

Day 1: Australia – Johannesburg. Fly from Australia to Johannesburg with South African Airways. Shuttle bus transfer from airport to the hotel.

Accommodation: Peermont Metcourt, Johannesburg – 1 night

Day 2: Johannesburg – Nairobi. Shuttle bus transfer from hotel to airport for flight to Nairobi with South African Airways. Transfer to hotel.

Accommodation: Boulevard Hotel, Nairobi – 1 night

Day 3: Commence East Africa Camping Safari – Nairobi. Morning at leisure. Late afternoon pre departure meeting.

Accommodation: Hotel Accommodation – 1 night

Day 4: Nairobi – Lake Nakuru. Leave the city behind and travel north and enjoy a fantastic view of the Great Rift Valley. Then descend into the valley and enter Lake Nakuru National Park. Enjoy a game drive in search of rhino, leopard, lion, buffalo and many other species that inhabit the park. Camp just below the equator at Kembu. (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Camping – 1 night

Day 5: Lake Naivasha. A short drive to the campsite on the shores of Lake Naivasha. In the afternoon visit Elsamere, the former home of Joy and George Adamson, for afternoon tea and to gain an insight into their fascinating lives. (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Camping – 1 night

Day 6: Masai Mara. Traverse through some of Kenya's finest wilderness, using lesser know roads, and pass Masai villages on the way. Camp for the next two nights adjacent to the world renowned Masai Mara National Park. (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Camping – 2 nights

Day 7: Masai Mara. Full day of extensive game driving. The Masai Mara is well known for its large herds and ever present predators. Lunch today will be picnic on the banks of the Mara River. Return to camp for the night. (B,L,D)

Day 8: Lake Victoria. Leaving the Masai Mara behind, enter Tanzania and then descend toward the shores of Africa's largest lake, Lake Victoria. Remainder of day at leisure. (B,L)

Accommodation: Camping – 1 night

Day 9: Serengeti. Today enter what is arguably the world's most acclaimed wildlife sanctuary, the Serengeti National Park. Traverse the park west to east doing extensive game drives. (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Camping – 1 night

Day 10: Ngorongoro Crater. Morning game drive. Then depart for Ngorongoro Conservation area where you will witness the spectacle of the Masai tribal people herding their cattle amongst the wildlife. Tonight camp at the renowned Simba camp on the edge of the magnificent Ngorongoro Crater. The views from the camp are spectacular. (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Camping – 1 night

Day 11: Ngorongoro. Descend into the crater and explore this marvel of nature with its sheer walls, fertile plains and abundant wildlife. Return to camp for lunch. Exit the park and descend the escarpment to camp at a village. (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Camping – 2 nights

Price Includes:

- Return economy class airfares from Australia to Nairobi, via Johannesburg, with South African Airways.
- 1 night in Johannesburg inclusive of breakfast, hotel provides courtesy transfers airport to hotel and vice versa.
- 2 nights in Nairobi, pre and post in Nairobi at Boulevard Hotel inclusive of breakfast.

Day 14: Nairobi. After breakfast return to Nairobi via shuttle bus. Arrive Nairobi, make own transfer to overnight accommodation. (B)
Accommodation: Boulevard Hotel, Nairobi – 1 night

Day 15: Nairobi – Johannesburg – Australia. Transferred to Nairobi Airport to connect with the return flight to Australia via Johannesburg with South African Airways. (B)
