Itinerary

Day 1: Fly Australia to Johannesburg. Transfer to Shongololo. Having a pre-day allows you to acclimatise and unpack prior to the first day of touring. (D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train remains at Johannesburg.

Day 2: Johannesburg. Day tour of Johannesburg, experience the mix of first and third world cultures and arts and crafts from all over Africa. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train departs this evening Johannesburg to Nelspruit.

Day 3: Swaziland. Enter Swaziland by road and enjoy the amazing views of the Ezulwini Valley and be introduced to the every day life in Africa's smallest kingdom. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train departs this evening to Maputo.

Day 4: Maputo. The capital of Mozambique is a city of contrast and offers an exciting mix of cultures. Enjoy the option of relaxing on the beach, going for a swim or taking the full day tour of the local area. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – trains remain stationed at Maputo.

Day 5: Maputo - Kruger National Park. Tour of Maputo and a visit to the market in the morning. Depart Maputo early this afternoon. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train departs this afternoon for Komatipoort

Day 6: Kruger National Park. A wildlife experience that equals the best anywhere. Full day game viewing or one of the may optional tours available. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train remains stationary at Komatipoort.

Day 7: Kruger National Park or Nelspruit. Sightseeing options available: Kruger National Park or tour through Nelspruit. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train will remain at Nelspruit for the night.

Day 8: Panorama Route. See Gods Window, the great Blyde River Canyon and the quaint town of Pilgrims Rest. Optional Sunrise Balloon Experience. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train departs this evening for Zimbabwe.

Day 9: Zimbabwe. Full day spent relaxing on the train. (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train travel to Zimbabwe.

Day 10: Great Zimbabwe. Visit the ancient ruins of the Rozwi people and see how they mined for gold and silver in the ancient city. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train departs to Somabhula.

Day 11: Antelope Park. Walk with the lions, visit the military museum or visit a local primary school. Option activities include overnight in a hut in the wild, canoe hire, game drives, horse back game viewing, elephant riding and many more local activities to choose from. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train departs to Bulawayo.

Day 12: Bulawayo and Matobo National Park. Matobo means "bald headed ones" and aptly describes the dramatic hills and granite rocks of this area. Sightseeing options: Matobo Hills and an Art Gallery or Matobo Hills and the Railway Museum. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo - train travels to Dete Station overnight.

Day 13: Hwange National Park. Early morning and afternoon game drive. Optional Tour to overnight in Hwange National Park. (B,D)

Overnight: Shongololo – train departs for Victoria Falls in the evening.

Day 14: Livingstone. Cross the great Zambezi River via the famous rail/road bridge. First stop is on the Zambian side before continuing to the town of Livingstone. Option of a Zambezi Boat Cruise. An off rail dinner is planned for this evening. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train remains stationed at Victoria Falls.

Day 15: Chobe National Park, Botswana. A 70 kilometre road trip to the Botswana border to visit the famous Chobe National Park. Highlights of today include game drives and a river cruise on the spectacular Chobe River. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train remains stationed at Victoria Falls.

Day 16: Victoria Falls. The largest single curtain of falling water on earth. The sound of the water can be heard from kilometres away and close up the muted 'thunder' sounds like a roar. Afternoon is at leisure to explore the vibrant markets and surrounds. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train remains stationed at Victoria Falls.

Day 17: Transfer to Airport. Fly to Australia via Johannesburg. (B)
