Selous Game Reserve will give you a view like no other as the train journeys down the escarpment and into the Reserve. Final stops on your train journey include visits to the towns of Dar Es Salaam and Bagamoyo, both rich in culture and history. A fitting end to this spectacular journey is a relaxing few days on the island of Zanzibar.

- Itinerary**
- Day 1: Fly Australia to Johannesburg.** Upon arrival met and transferred to hotel for overnight stay.
Accommodation: Peerment Metcourt Suites (or similar), Johannesburg – 1 night
 - Day 2: Fly Johannesburg to Livingstone.** Transfer to Victoria Falls where the Shongololo awaits. Having a pre-day allows you to acclimatise and unpack prior to the first day of optional touring available (should time permit). (B,D)
Accommodation: Shongololo – train remains in Victoria Falls.
 - Day 3: Victoria Falls – Chobe National Park.** Cross over the Botswana border and into Chobe National Park. Enjoy a game drive in a 4x4 vehicle and a river cruise on the Chobe River. After lunch (own expense) travel back to Victoria Falls for overnight. (B,D)
Accommodation: Shongololo – train remains in Victoria Falls

The train travels comfortably and securely through the night to the next stop on the itinerary and you awake each morning to a fresh vista of Africa and the anticipation of a new and exciting adventure. In this way Shongololo guests can make the most of every precious holiday hour.

Each train carries a fleet of air-conditioned Mercedes Benz touring vehicles with professional guides on board (English, German, Dutch or French speaking) who are ready to take guest on inclusive scheduled tours to experience the unique sights of the area. For the more adventurous there are also a wide variety of tour add-ons at various locations.

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Day 4: Victoria Falls – Livingstone. Spend time visiting the many curio and craft shops that the Victoria Falls township has to offer before transferring to the Falls area on the Zambian side. Continue onto the town of Livingstone, where you will meet and reboard the train. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train travels overnight to Lusaka

Day 5: On the rails to Lusaka. Spend the day on the rails through the south of Zambia towards its capital, Lusaka. See rural Africa as it passes by – miles and miles of flat landscape dotted with rural communities and Mopani trees. (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train remains stationery in Lusaka.

Day 6: Lusaka – South Luangwa National Park. Today a city tour of Lusaka enroute to Chaminuka Lodge for overnight stay. (B,D)

Accommodation: Chaminuka Lodge, South Luangwa National Park – 1 night.

Day 7: Lusaka – Serenje. Spend another day at Chaminuka Lodge participating in the many activities on offer. Return back to the train later in the day. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train travels overnight to Serenje.

Day 8: Serenje – Livingstone Memorial – Kundalila Falls. This morning continue the journey on the tracks of Dr Livingstone to the place where he died and where a memorial now stands. Enjoy the pleasant drive from Serenje, passing the Kasanka National Park. Before returning to the train, visit the Kundalila Falls (meaning “Crying Dove”). (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train travels overnight to Kasama.

Day 9: Scenic Escarpment Drop. A highlight of your journey will be today’s train ride as it includes a spectacular daylight drop off the escarpment. A border cross into Tanzania will be made at Tunduma. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train travels overnight to Makambako.

Day 10: Makambako (Tanzania). After arrival at Makambako, visit the Isimila Stone Age site near the bustling municipality of Iringa. Visit a thriving market full of fresh foods and locally made handicrafts. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train travels overnight to Kisaki Station.

Day 11: Selous Game Reserve. Depart the train for a full day game drive in Selous Game Reserve. Selous is the largest of its kind in Africa covering almost 6% of Tanzania’s land surface and is home to a myriad of wildlife and species of bird and reptiles. Optional extras (own expense) include an overnight at a lodge in Selous and walking safaris. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train remains stationery overnight at Kisaki Station.

Day 12: Kisaki – Overnight to Dar Es Salaam. Half day tour to the communal lands to experience the life style of the indigenous people of this region. Return to the train for lunch and afternoon at own leisure. (B,D)

Accommodation: Shongololo – train travels overnight to Dar Es Salaam.

Day 13: Dar Es Salaam. Arrive in the bustling seaport of Dar Es Salaam, situated at the crossroads of some of the most important sea routes on the Indian Ocean. The city is an eclectic mix of architecture, reflecting its colonial past and more recent history. Visit nearby Bagamoyo, a town steeped in much history and interesting sights.

Accommodation: Shongololo – train remains stationery in Dar Es Salaam.

Day 14: Dar Es Salaam to Zanzibar. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Zanzibar. Upon arrival met and transferred to your hotel for the next 3 nights, including breakfast and dinner. (B,D)

Accommodation: Blue Bay Resort (or similar), Zanzibar – 3 nights.

Day 15 - 16: Zanzibar. Morning Spice Island Tour then spend the afternoon on a Stone Town Tour. Remainder of time at own leisure. (B,D)

Day 17: Nairobi – Johannesburg – Australia. Met and transferred to the airport. Fly to Australia via Johannesburg. (B)
